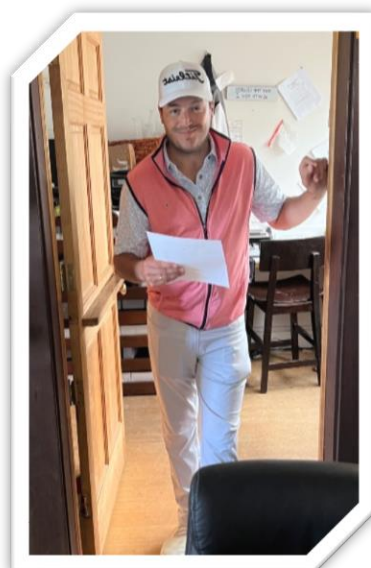
MESSAGE FROM TEE TIME CHAIR

1. Tee times open on Leaderboard at 3PM every Thursday for the following Thursday play.
 2. You can make changes on Leaderboard until Tues AM. A tee sheet is sent out to all players. If you need to make a last minute change, please contact me (via email or text). On Wednesday afternoon, a final sheet is sent to all players and the Pro Shop. If there are any changes after this sheet is sent, players need to contact the Pro Shop.
- Due to Pro Shop scheduling and staffing the earlier I send the list, the better it is for them. I will send final notice on Wednesday before 3PM. Everyone is doing a great job communicating! Thanks!

You may sign up yourself and three other members the week prior to play on Thursday at 3PM.

CHECKING IN

Please check in at least 20 min. before your scheduled tee time. Please be on the first tee box and ready to swing 5 min. before play

CANCELLING A TEE TIME

If you need to make a change or cancel your tee time, you may do so online before Tuesday at 8:00 am. After this date and time, you must contact the Tee Time Chair via text or email. The Tee Time Chair will send out a final list to all players and the Pro Shop on Wednesday by 3:00 pm. If you need to cancel after this time, you must contact the Longshore Golf Course directly. Tee sheets are sent to Longshore Golf Course so that unused tee times are available to the public. If you fail to properly cancel your tee time and are a "no show" you may be charged at the discretion of the golf course.
